9. CLBC STATEMENT OF FAITH

- We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.

- We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.

I understand that Canal Lake Bible Camp is a ministry of the House of Prayer Interdenominational Church. I understand and agree that if I offend this standard of conduct, my involvement may be terminated by CLBC. Furthermore I understand that CLBC reserves the right to terminated by position at any time with or without cause or notice.
- I authorize CLBC and/or its agents to verify any information I have provided. I authorize all former employers, companies, schools, or references and any law enforcement agency to release any information about my background and hereby release these entities from any liability or damage whatsoever in issuing this information.
- I have answered all questions completely and accurately to the best of my ability and understand that any false statement, misrepresentation, or omission made on this application and/or in my interview is grounds for terminating the application process or my involvement with CLBC.
- Except for times of pre-approved absence, I am expected to actively carry out my responsibilities as a counselor at CLBC. Failure to cary out my responsibilities at CLBC is cause for terminating my position.
